Rehabilitation Appliances Program (RAP) in Residential Aged Care (RAC) List

The **Australian National - Aged Care Classifications (AN-ACC)**, applies to residential aged care facilities (RACF). Residents of these facilities will be independently assessed and the RACF will be funded based on the client's clinical need. This funding will enable RACFs to provide client's aids and appliances to meet their clinical need(s), as specified in Schedule 1 of the Quality of Care Principles.

Where a RACF is funded to provide an aid or appliance, it is expected to do so. DVA does not seek to duplicate these arrangements.

RAC funded aids and appliances

The RACF is funded to provide:

Standard - Fit-for-purpose "off the shelf" product chosen by the aged care home which is suitable for use by the general resident population;

Non-standard - Fit-for-purpose "off-the-shelf" product chosen by the aged care home which differs to the standard normally provided, but which does not have the personalised features/functionality of a customised product.

The non-standard product is required to meet the particular needs of an individual resident (as assessed by a health professional), but is reusable for caring for other residents who have similar needs.

DVA will fund

DVA will fund customised products for eligible veterans and war widow/ers living in RACFs.

Customised product includes:


- a **custom-made product** to meet the specific care needs of an individual resident (assessed/prescribed by a health provider).
- an **advanced model of a product** with extra features which are needed to meet assessed care needs, when a lower specification model that meets the definition of a standard or non-standard product is also available.
- a product prescribed by a suitable health provider to meet a client's clinical need that is beyond the scope of what the RACF is funded to provide.

A customised product differs significantly to the standard normally provided. The product is not reusable for caring for other residents, as they will not have a need for the personalised features/functionality.

Speak to the RACF first - check if they are responsible for supplying a particular aid or appliance to the client. If the RACF is not responsible, contact us to check the client's eligibility.

To order an item on the RAC list - Please check the RAP National Schedule of Equipment for further information on the correct form to use and if a National RAP Guideline applies to this item.
