No one could ever fulfil the criteria at that time for a successful claim. Rotator Cuff syndrome and Osteoarthritis was bandied about, to and fro , during my claim, which was eventually dismissed.

However, if accepted , this claim would have got me to TPI.

Presently my right shoulder is to be examined again and a shoulder reversal is necessary. My left is not much better. This diagnosis confirms that I was correct at the time and had to let the claim elapse.

I am currently EDA.

My point is ,I have been monetarily disadvantaged since that period when I was clearly suffering from my original claim, and now have to undergo major surgery. Recompense , and backpay to TPI status from the date of my claim should be initiated.
